- Dogs may enter and run FEO without a number.
- Your dog will need to be measured by a judge Saturday and/or Sunday mornings.

CONFIRMATION: Confirmations will be emailed. If you do not receive a confirmation by 1 week prior to the trial date, or if there are errors, please notify the Trial Secretary as soon as possible. This will help avoid delays on the day of the trial.

TRIAL SITE: This trial will be held outdoors on grass. Rain or Shine

CRATING AND SET-UP: There will be plenty of space ring side for set up of shade tents etc. We will have someone to watch over the trial area in the evenings, please be aware that leaving valuables on-site overnight is at the risk of the owner. Please be aware that there is an underground sprinkler system. No pegs over 6" long allowed.

CONCESSION: 100 Mile Lions will be having a concession throughout the week-end. Restaurants are within walking/driving distance.

Creature Focus Photography will be on site to capture your agility moments.

AAC ID CARDS, CHECK IN AND MEASURING: If your dog does not have a completed AAC card, please order it well in advance (form enclosed) from AAC. You must have your dog measured and your card marked with that measurement before your first run. Measuring will be available between 7:15 a.m.-7:30 a.m. Competitors must have their dog ID cards with them, but do not necessarily have to be checked in if the card is complete.

EQUIPMENT FAMILIARIZATION / WALK THRU'S: Contact equipment only. Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:20 a.m. walk thru 7:50 am throughout the weekend walk thru's may be split for bigger classes.

FIRST DOG ON THE LINE: 8 am Saturday & Sunday

CLASS CHANGE/MOVE-UPS: Next day move-ups will be allowed. Please report move-ups on move-up sheet. Move ups from prior trials must be reported no later than noon Monday, Aug 24th, 2010 - Please email Roxanne Ziefflie of any move ups immediately at caribooagilityteam@shaw.ca

I/We, the undersigned, agree that the host club has the right to refuse my entry for causes, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the event and the opportunity to have the dog participate or be judged:

I/We agree to hold the organizing committee, the organization which it represents including its members, officers and directors, the Agility Association of Canada, sponsors of the event, owner of the premises upon which the event is being held and their employees, harmless from any claims for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any persons or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near entrances thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I/We further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from claims of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, death or otherwise be caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by negligence of any person, or any cause or causes.

REMINDERS TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- This event is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or any dogs showing signs of aggression.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC (rules are available online www.aac.ca).
- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, including during familiarization and course-walking. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.
- All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior upon exit of the ring may be disqualified and / or required to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND of fees shall be given.
- Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great venue available to us and other dog clubs!
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made.
- If an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.
- There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/ injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.

CLASS PROGRESSION

AAC Starters Class: The starters class shall be for dogs not having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. A dog must achieve 3 clear rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the ADC title.

AAC Advanced Class: The advanced class shall be for dogs that having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title, but that have not earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. A dog must achieve 3 clear rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the AADC title.

AAC Masters Class: The Masters class shall be for dogs having earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. To be awarded the Master Agility Dog of Canada (MADC) title by the AAC, a dog must achieve 3 clear standard rounds under 2 different judges. An Agility Trial Champion of Canada (ATCHC) must earn a MADC and a MGDC.

AAC Veterans Class: These classes shall be for dogs seven years of age or older that are currently competing in any Standard Agility Class and for dogs five years of age or older who have competed in the Specials Agility Class for a minimum of one calendar year. A dog may no longer compete in standard titling classes after being entered at an official trial in any Veteran class.

AAC Special Classes: These classes are open to all dogs but are intended for dogs that for any reason the handler elects that it is best for the dog to jump one jump height lower than the dog would at it's regular jump height. A dog in Specials will have the option to move into Regular classes once during the dog's career.

Games Titles & Progressions: Two Starters game leg must be earned to progress in that game. Once 2 legs are earned in each game a Starters Games Dog title is earned. In Advanced games, 3 legs must be earned under two DIFFERENT judges in each game to earn an Advanced games Dog title. Once three qualifiers are earned in a game, the dog must enter Masters classes in that game. In Masters, 4 legs are required under two different judges to earn a Masters title in that game.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

For complete rules visit the Agility Association of Canada's website: www.acc.ca

STANDARD AGILITY: This game demonstrates the dog's and handler's ability to perform all obstacles. The sequence of the obstacles, and the time required to complete the sequence, will be determined by the Judge.

JUMPERS: This game demonstrates a dog's natural jumping ability, The dog is required to complete a course comprised of jumps and tunnels as prescribed by the Judge,

SNOOKER: This game demonstrates the handler and dog's versatility as they work together against the clock. The object of the game is to accumulate as many points as possible in the opening and closing sequences with in the allotted time.

GAMBLERS: This game demonstrates the handler's strategy and the dog's ability to work at a distance from the handler. The object of the game is to accumulate as many points as possible during the opening sequence and successfully complete the gamble.

TEAM RELAY: This game demonstrates team spirit, strategy and sportsmanship. Effect Jan 1, 2009 The Masters Team Relay Dog of Canada will require 2 Starters, 3 Advanced and 4 Masters Team Relay Q's.

Steeplechase: This game demonstrates the dog's ability to run and jump at high speeds while maintaining control on the A-Frame and weave poles.

Challenge Class: This game tests the handling skills as well as the speed of the agility team. The level of this class is to reflect a similarity to World Level courses in its difficulty and handling requirements.
